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<p>Description or summary of the proposed project</p>	<p>The project aims to create a theatre performance entitled “A Good Man”, exploring how norms of masculinity affect men and what men can gain in a more gender-equal society.</p> <p>The creative process is based on a European research approach, involving fieldwork with men from diverse social and cultural backgrounds, particularly in countries recognized for their progress in gender equality (Scandinavian countries, Iceland).</p> <p>This research will take the form of interviews, meetings, and workshops, gathering personal testimonies and life stories that will serve as the foundation for the writing process.</p> <p>The project is grounded in a co-creation methodology with European partners, involving artists, researchers, and local participants at different stages of the process (research, writing, and artistic experimentation). This approach aims to develop a performance shaped by diverse cultural perspectives.</p> <p>This methodology seeks to generate multi-level impact:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • for audiences, by fostering reflection and dialogue on masculinity norms and gender equality; • at societal level, by contributing to evolving representations and creating inclusive spaces for discussion; • for artists, by developing new collaborative practices at the European level and enriching artistic processes through field research. <p>The project also includes a European dissemination strategy, with performances presented in partner countries, accompanied by audience discussions to encourage the circulation of works and cross-cultural dialogue.</p>
